JUDY CARMICHAEL

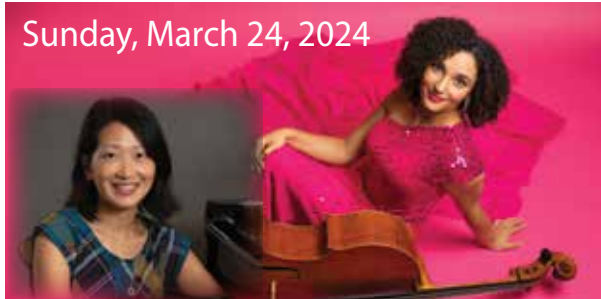
